Whereas, the incubation of the Fountain Hills Community Center plan began during Mayor Jerry Miles' term, he initiated the major fund-raiser that furnished the River of Time Museum and developed and continues to be central to the River of Time Museum Foundation; and

Whereas, The Fountain Hills Sister Cities program was established during Mayor Jerry Miles' term; Jackie Miles has served on the Sister Cities Committee and is the current President; and

Whereas, FireRock, Eagle Mountain, and the CopperWynd developments were put into place, The Hillside Protection Ordinance, the temporary sign ordinance, and a bed tax were approved during Mayor Jerry Miles' term; and

Whereas, Fountain Park and the Avenue of the Fountains median were acquired from MCO by the Town during Mayor Jerry Miles' term; and
