Shea Blvd Right of Way	Not allowed anytime	Not allowed anytime
Median (center or side road)	Not allowed anytime	Not allowed anytime
Sign Free Zone (see attached) Rights of way	Temporary A-frame, Post and Board, and Yard signs allowed consistent with the requirements in Zoning Ordinance Section 6.08	Not allowed anytime
Other Street Rights of Way	Allowed consistent with State Statutes and Zoning Ordinance Section 6.08	Allowed beginning 71 days prior to primary (August 4, 2026)
Town Owned Property (Town Hall, parks, etc.)	Not allowed anytime	Not allowed anytime
Private Property	Residential: 1 post and board sign per street front, anytime 1 flag pole with up to 2 flags, anytime 4 yard signs, anytime Nonresidential: 2 A-frames per business, anytime 1 banner per business, anytime up to 30 days/year 2 flag poles and up to 2 flags per pole, anytime 1 post and board per street front, anytime 1 yard sign lot, anytime	N/A

- Distance varies, usually about 8' – 12'


