Fountain Hills is located in Maricopa County and borders Fort McDowell Yavapai Nation, the Salt River Pima Maricopa Indian Community and Scottsdale.

The Town's elevation is 1,520 feet at the fountain, 3,000 feet on Golden Eagle Boulevard and 500 feet above Phoenix and covers 24 square miles.

Incorporated in 1989, Fountain Hills is home to nearly 24,000 residents. The Town employs the council-manager form of government. Fountain Hills is administered by a seven member Town Council which oversees all issues pertaining to Fountain Hills, including residential and commercial development and preservation of natural areas.

Residents in Fountain Hills enjoy an upscale lifestyle. **Per capita income is among the highest with a median household income of \$87,080.**

Fountain Hills is conveniently close to key locations not only within Arizona, but across the Southwest.

Experience Fountain Hills.

The centerpiece of Fountain Hills is our beautiful fountain which is one of the world's tallest man-made fountains. It serves as a focal point for the community and attracts thousands of visitors each year.

The fountain was built in 1970 by Robert McCulloch the year before reconstruction of the London Bridge in Lake Havasu City, another of McCulloch's projects. The fountain sprays water for about fifteen minutes every hour at the top of the hour. The plume rises from a concrete water lily sculpture in the center of a large man-made lake. Fountain Hills offers an escape for locals and visitors alike, with spectacular year-round outdoor recreation and quality events throughout the year from art and wine festivals, to live music, to cultural celebrations.

Vision for the Future

As Fountain Hills grows, the Town is committed to sustaining the quality of life, vitality, and it's distinct charm; maintaining the delicate balance of land uses that make the Town a desirable place to live, work, enjoy, and visit; further enrich the natural, built, and social environments that make the Town unique; support existing businesses and continue to attract businesses that stimulate the Town's economy; and provide recreational and resort opportunities to strengthen the Town's reputation as a premier desert destination.

Healthcare & Education

The Town is home to the Fountain Hills Medical Center, which provides 24-hour emergency room services and Honor Health Urgent Care and Primary Care.

Achieving and celebrating academic excellence, Fountain Hills Unified School District serves approximately 1,300 students, drawing learners from the Town of Fountain Hills, nearby Fort McDowell Yavapai Nation, and others whose parents prefer the safe, more intimate environment the District provides.
