


Residential Bulk Waste Collection

REMINDER: Bulk is ONE day per zone. Items must be on the curb by 6 a.m.

Place bulk material curbside no earlier than the weekend prior to and no later than 6 a.m. on your scheduled bulk collection day. Bulk items not placed before 6 a.m. will be considered late, resulting in additional pickup fees.



✓ Acceptable Bulk Waste Items

- › Items too large to fit in the waste cart
- › Furniture and some appliances (Freon® must be removed)
- › Branches no more than 4' in length and no larger than 24" in diameter; must be bundled and tied with wire or heavy twine



✗ Unacceptable Bulk Waste Items

- › Household hazardous waste (paint, chemicals, oil)
- › Loose grass, leaves, weeds, twigs and hedge clippings that are not bagged or tied
- › Bricks, concrete, dirt, rocks, tile, asphalt, roofing or similar materials
- › Construction material in excess of 25 pounds or longer than 4 feet generated by a resident; any construction materials generated by a contractor
- › Metal, rebar and fence posts
- › Tires, rims or automobile parts
- › Untaped glass (windows, shower doors, patio doors, mirrors, etc.*)
- › Any appliances containing Freon®

Bulk waste is material that cannot be placed in the waste cart, like furniture, some appliances and large amounts of vegetation.

- › Not to exceed 6 cubic yards (4'h x 6'w x 6'd)
- › Must be neatly stacked, bagged, boxed and/or tied
- › Must be placed at least 5 feet from any fixed object:
 - › Utility pole
 - › Cable box
 - › Mailbox
 - › Water meter
 - › Parked car, etc.

*Glass is accepted as long as it is taped to ensure it doesn't break. This is a safety concern for the community and Republic Services employees.
