

Storm Water Management

When it rains, there are different types of inlets to collect the water. The water is then routed via curbs/gutters, pipes, open channels and other conveyances to community retention basins, parks and area floodways. The runoff does not go to a treatment plant.

In order to protect the quality of storm water runoff, the Town of Fountain Hills obtained a permit from the Environmental Protection Agency in 2003. That permit requires Fountain Hills to implement a number of different programs called Best Management Practices (BMPs). Some of these BMPs include:

- Retention Basin Maintenance
- Public Education
- Storm Drain Maintenance
- Oversight of Industrial Facilities
- Street Sweeping
- Support of Oil Recycling
- Oversight of Construction Sites

In addition to these BMPs, the Town of Fountain Hills is preparing a storm water ordinance, which will prohibit the discharge of pollutants into the storm drain system.
