Emergency Order of Protection

If you are in immediate danger, call 911.

Orders of Protection can be issued by any Court in Arizona. If the Court has closed for business, Emergency Orders of Protection are granted by a judge in writing, verbally or telephonically to protect a person who is in imminent danger of domestic violence. Emergency Orders of Protection are available from local law enforcement agencies.

The Fountain Hills Sheriff's Non-Emergency number is (480) 252-7840.

The Sheriff's Office will dispatch an officer to review your situation. If appropriate, the officer will contact the Court after hours to request the Court grant an emergency Order of Protection. If the order is granted, it will be a temporary order, only good until the close of the next day of Court business following the day the Emergency Order was issued. You will need to go back to the Protective Order Center the next business day to complete and file a Petition for a permanent Order of Protection.
